- Provide any important documents to the High School at your earliest convenience. We require the following documents:**
 - birth certificate
 - passport of travel documents for non-Australian born students
 - current court orders (where relevant)
 - medical management plans such as asthma, anaphylaxis, diabetes, seizures etc
 - paediatric learning assessments and/or management plans for dyslexia, ADHD, dyscalculia etc

- School Uniform:** All items are available from Work Locker (120 Murphy St, Wangaratta) Uniform list is available on our website and was on the information sheet shared on the 15th September 2022. *Please note that all Year 7 students will be provided with a quality Wangaratta High School backpack on their Transition Days in December 2022.*
- Textbooks and stationary:** All enrolling students will be provided with details on how to order books from our supplier, Lilydale Books - <https://www.lilydalebooks.com.au/>. This will be open to families from Tuesday, 8th November 2022. Orders are submitted online and delivered to the address of your choice in early 2023. They can provide textbooks and stationery. You also have the option of ordering stationary locally at a store of your choice. *The school provides all Year 7 students with a combination lock for their locker and an official Student Diary on their first day of school.*
- Bring Your Own Device (BYOD):** All students require their own laptop, and in 2023 they will be required to bring it to school every day for use with their learning. *More information will be provided about special purchasing options later in 2023. All required software is provided by the school at no cost, including Microsoft Office 365, Adobe Creative Suite and more.*
